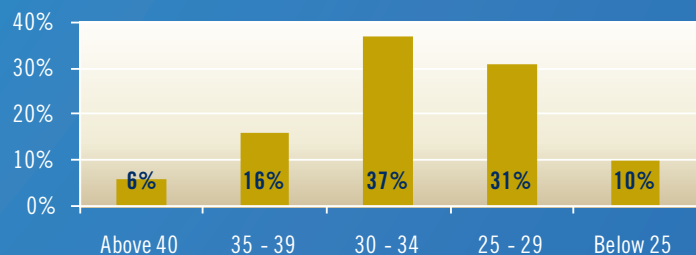

## 2010 Study Score Analysis

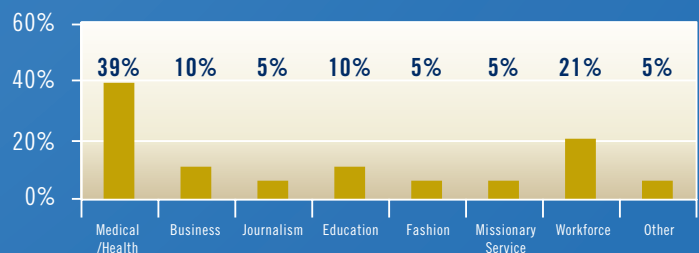
Study scores above 40 represent top 9% of students in the State.
